

RUSSIA FEDERATION: RELEASE ALEKSANDRA SKOCHILENKO IMMEDIATELY AND UNCONDITIONALLY



ARTIST AND ANTI-WAR ACTIVISTS SENTENCED TO SEVEN YEARS IN PRISON



Troubled by Russia's invasion of Ukraine, Aleksandra "Sasha" Skochilenko, a songwriter and artist in St. Petersburg, decided to protest.

On 31 March 2022, she replaced price tags in a local supermarket in Saint Petersburg with paper labels containing anti-war messages.

On November 16, 2023 Aleksandra was sentenced to seven years in prison for "disseminating knowingly false information about the Russian Armed Forces".

Aleksandra Skochilenko suffers from celiac disease and heart disease and her health has deteriorated greatly during this time.

Aleksandra is a prisoner of conscience.

On August 1, 2024, Aleksandra was released from prison as part of a prisoner swap between the U.S.-Russia.
