CHINA: RELEASE UYGHUR STUDENT KAMILE WAYIT IMMEDIATELY

Kamile Wayit, a Uyghur university student majoring in pre-school education at the Shangqiu Institute of Technology in Henan, was detained on December 12, 2022, and sentenced to 3 years imprisonment under the charge of "promoting extremism." These charges were reportedly based on Kamile having shared a video on Chinese social media app WeChat about a nationwide peaceful protest in China that commemorated victims of the Urumqi Fire. Kamile is being detained solely for the peaceful exercise of her right to freedom of expression. We call on you to release Kamile Wayit, stop the crackdown on dissenting voices in China, and cease targeting individuals for exercising their right to freedom of expression.
